All our students have been working hard over the last term on the Roman Empire and Volcanoes as Topics from the Colosseum, Pompei & chariots to Larva, magma, and the tectonic plates. We have touched upon this in our topic of Romans with Pompei. We are making our own erupting Volcano and learning about where they are in the world and why they erupt.

They have all really enjoyed the Topic.

We have undergone new training with Read Write Inc Phonics, this has been going down well with students helping to encourage reading for pleasure in school and at home. Using 1-1 sessions for all to build their confidence in reading and spelling.

Since our last OFSTED inspection, we have been working hard to redesign our Curriculum to enhance the learning of all students. We have introduced the AQA Unit Awards across every subject. This means each term all students will be gaining Certificates and building a portfolio of their achievements. We are also now able to offer BTECH Qualifications. We have seen an increase in knowledge being retained by all students over the last term.
